

How to have a great Dermatology Visit !

- Consider wearing or bringing a pair of shorts.
- Skip make-up, moisturizers, or sunscreens on exam day. Apply them after the examination!
- Tell the Medical Assistant all your concerns upon your arrival. This will ensure that they will be given adequate attention and documentation.
- Covering towels/blankets are available. Do not wrap around. Ask the Medical Assistant to demonstrate how to use them.
- Tell/remind us if you have special needs or sensitivities, i.e. bleeding tendency, latex, adhesives, phobias, fainting, pregnancy, breast feeding, HIV, hepatitis, new allergies, pacemaker.
- Know your medications. Tell/remind us if you are taking aspirin or a blood thinner. Keep a list of your medications including supplements and non-prescription medications.
- Let us know if you are on a tight schedule.
- Wait in the exam room at the end of the examination. The Medical Assistant will review your treatment, demonstrate products, and help you schedule return visits.
